There are approximately 700 international students in Monterey, along with their families. Following are a few overview details about the current ISI ministry in Monterey:

Overview

New team members moving into open positions will come alongside current leaders to work together, assuming leadership roles when appropriate, in this well-established ISI local ministry. ISI Monterey is seeking energetic, tech-savvy individuals to reach out effectively with the current generation of international students/families. Positions can be ideal for individuals or a couple, working either part- or full-time.

Monterey boasts two small specialized private graduate schools. Our smaller campuses provide many opportunities for one-on-one personal connections with international students, scholars, and their families.

- **Middlebury Institute of International Studies (MIIS)** offers programs for students developing careers centered around international diplomacy. Their goal is to be solutions on the world playing field, and their motto is “ready to change the world.” Programs offered at MIIS are related exclusively to language translation/interpretation, international diplomacy, trade, public policy education and environmental studies, as well as non-proliferation, and anti-terrorism. These strategic international students are ready to impact the world. ISI Monterey’s team are here to offer them the Gospel of Jesus Christ to take with them as they do so.
- **Naval Postgraduate School (NPS)** is for highly specialized military research/support studies and hosts high-ranking military officers at master’s and doctoral degree levels. They come from all around the world, and many bring their families with them.

ISI in Monterey has two distinct ministry opportunities for staff or volunteer Ministry Reps:

- Outreach to international students/scholars at MIIS—a perfect opportunity for a couple wishing to minister jointly.
- International Women’s Connection (IWC)—While NPS officers are focused on their high-security research, their wives stay at home and yearn for friendship with other women. An IWC gathering often draws 20-30 women from multiple countries. The Monterey IWC team is here for them, offering friendship, an opportunity for community with other international women, and fun or informational events to help them in their adjustment to life in America. This is an exciting and dynamic opportunity for a female ISI team member.
